

Lake Texoma Fishing Report

Fall fishing is in full swing. Water temp ranging around 62 degrees with the bass being scattered. Shad are starting to move into shallow bays and flats. You can catch fish on steep rock banks by throwing crankbaits, white splatterback Bandit or a white/lavender Lucky Craft working well. Catching good bass in 2 feet of water throwing a Tennessee Shad Rat-L-Trap beating it along the bottom. Soft plastics are working well in the June Bug color as well as Peanut and Butter Jelly jigs with purple trailer. Good fish being taken north of the railroad bridge as well as in Big Mineral. Bass are being caught against the bank.
